ACADEMIC ALERT @ GMC – Starfish Flag Guide



This guide provides flag names and definitions available in Starfish.

PROGRESS SURVEY FLAGS	These are flags that appear in the Progress Surveys, but can also be raised manually at any point in the term.
Attendance Concern	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student who does not participate in class as expected or continues to be tardy. Online instructors should raise this flag when a student has not participated in the course in more than 7 days. Student receives an email.
Low Quiz/Exam Scores	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student that received a low score on a quiz or exam. Student receives an email.
Low Assignment Scores	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student that received a low score on a graded assignment or discussion forums. Student receives an email.
Missing Graded Activities	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student that has failed to turn in graded work. Student receives an email.
In Danger of Being Withdrawn	Instructors should raise this flag when a student is close to violating the attendance policy. Student receives an email and a Success Coach will contact the student.
In Danger of Failing	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student that may be in danger of failing a course. Student receives an email and a Success Coach will contact the student.
General Concern	Instructors, Advisors, and Success Coaches can raise this flag to report any academic-related issue that does not have a specific flag. Comments are required. Student receives an email.
Keep Up the Good Work	Give a student positive reinforcement on their good work in the course so far. Student receives an email.
MANUAL FLAGS	These are flags that do not appear in the Progress Survey, but can be raised at any point in the term.
Academic Dishonesty	Instructors can raise this flag to report a student that has cheated, plagiarized, or committed any other act of Academic Dishonesty. Comments are required. Student receives an email. This does not replace the Honor Council Referral form.
Behavioral Concern	Instructors, Advisors, and Success Coaches can raise this flag to report when a student's behavioral, mental, or physical health is concerning. <i>Comments are required. Student does NOT receive an email.</i>
KUDOS	Kudos provide positive reinforcement to students.
Keep Up the Good Work	Raise this kudo when a student is performing well in a course. Student receives an email.
Outstanding Academic Performance	Raise this kudo when a student has outstanding academic performance in a course. Student receives an email.
Showing Improvement	Raise this kudo when a student has shown improvement in a course. Student receives an email.
I NEED HELP	Students can raise this flag on themselves when they aren't sure where to go to for help.
I Need Help	Select this flag when you know you need help, but are not sure where to start. A Success Coach will be notified.
